### EXERCISE PLAN FOR PEOPLE OVER 50:

Begin by standing on a comfortable surface, where you have plenty of room at each side. With a 5-lb. potato bag in each hand, extend your arms straight out from your sides and hold them there as long as you can. Try to reach a full minute, then relax.

Each day you'll find that you can hold this position for just a bit longer. After a couple weeks, move up to 10-lb. potato bags. Then try 50-lb. potato bags and eventually try to get to where you can lift a 100-lb. potato bag in each hand and hold your arms straight for more than a full minute. (I'm at this level.)

After you feel confident at that level (wait for it), put a potato in each bag.

She caught Greta with her head in a big bag of dog chow gulping it down like crazy. Amanda said her name and she knew she was in trouble.

Christmas came and Amanda wasn't in the Christmas spirit. Greta, myself, and our feline

sister Sydney LOVE Christmas. Amanda finally got in the decorating mood and said we were going to have a great last Christmas for Greta. Boy did we ever!

We were all so happy that Greta made it through the holidays. Amanda told her she now had to make it to her 13<sup>th</sup> birthday on January 15<sup>th</sup>. Our vet Dr. Deb couldn't believe how well she was doing. Greta made it to 13 as you saw in the January newsletter.





This match is the week end before the Seattle Kennel Club show. If you plan to enter that show, then this will be a good place to enter for some last-minute practice.







Two endorsements by current members must be provided by new applicants. Applicant's name will be published in the German Shepherd Dog Review. Provided no objections have been filed within 30 days of publication in the Review, applicant will be notified that he/she is eligible for all privileges including the right to vote. **Junior Members:** Must be 10 years of age and not more than 18 years of age and shall subscribe to the same criteria as Regular Membership with the exception of the requirement to pay dues.
